## **Terms & Conditions for the casual use of the whitewater facility**

- All paddlers shall wear a means of identification (bib) to display that they have signed on to the whitewater course and have paid the current appropriate fee (this includes season ticket holders). In signing on, the paddler agrees to abide by the terms and conditions for casual use.
- All paddlers should hold a BCU 3 Star Award or above for the type of craft they are using. They should be competent on grade 2 / 3 water, and should be able to roll in such conditions. Persons not deemed competent will not be allowed on the Nene Whitewater Course and the Centre's decision will be final
- All paddlers shall wear buoyancy aids and helmets at all times. Any individual disregarding this rule shall be asked to leave.
- All paddlers should exercise courtesy and politeness to others, and should try wherever possible to abide by the Centre's guidelines (which can be viewed at reception). Any paddler who chooses to disregard this, or is acting irresponsibly shall be asked to leave.
- The parent / guardian of any paddler under the age of 18 years, must have completed a Parental Consent Form.
- The Nene Card is valid for 12 months and is not transferable
- The Nene Card must be handed in at the beginning of each session where it will be retained for safe keeping, then handed back to you at the end of the session on return of the numbered bib.
- Nene Cards remain the property of the Nene Whitewater Centre Ltd.
- The minimum qualification for a Group Leader is BCU / WCA / SCA / CANI Coach Level 3 Award (relevant to the type of crafts the group are about to use).
- A Group Leader must bring proof of his Level 3 qualification on every visit to the Centre. The Duty Coach / Manager shall check the validity of the qualification prior to any signing on.
- The group leader shall sign on all members of his or her group, and shall operate within the guidelines set by his NGB, and relevant to their award. The group leader is wholly responsible for the group for the duration and participation of any activity. Maximum coach to student ratio is: 1:6
- 1 group leader shall only be allowed to sign on 6 group members.
